

## Observance of the Rules of Correct Recitation in Canonic Prayers - 24 /Nov/ 2019

uestion| Is it obligatory to observe the rules of correct Qur'anic recitation ( $tajw\bar{t}d$ )—such as  $madd\ l\bar{a}zim$  (required prolongation) and  $idgh\bar{a}m$  (contraction)—in performing the canonic prayers?

answer| It is not obligatory to observe the rules of correct Qur'anic recitation in the canonic prayers. Yet, it is recommended, as a matter of advisory caution ( $iht\bar{i}y\bar{a}t$  mustahabb), that worshippers implement madd  $l\bar{a}zim$ , refrain from pronouncing the connective sound when pausing (al-waqf bi al-harakah) or from connecting two words while omitting the connective sound between them (al-waşl bi al-suk $\bar{u}n$ ), and make the pronunciational contraction ( $idgh\bar{u}m$ ) upon encountering the  $Yarmal\bar{u}n$  letters.
