

Cautionary Jabīrah Wudū' or Ghusl - 21 /Nov/ 2022

Question: I work with paint and glue and it is not possible to work with gloves. I always remove the obstacle before $wud\bar{u}$ and ghusl as much as I can. But sometimes after prayer, $wud\bar{u}$ or ghusl, I see an obstacle that I did not see before. If there was an obstacle and I couldn't get sight of it, is $wud\bar{u}$ or ghusl considered a $jab\bar{t}rah$ one?

Answer: If it is one of the cases in which the $wud\bar{u}$ of $jab\bar{u}rah$ is allowed, you can pass your wet hand on the $wud\bar{u}$ member — on which you think there can be an obstacle — with the intention of $wud\bar{u}$, in addition to washing it.
