

IR Leader receives Chamber of Commerce members - 12 /Jul/ 2011

Islamic Revolution Leader Ayatollah Sayyed Ali Khamenei urged the authorities to provide the public with a genuine, hopeful assessment of the country's economic situation, adding such a hopeful assessment was a prerequisite to a successful economic jihad (the major economic drive of the current Iranian year). Ayatollah Khamenei made the remarks in a meeting with head and members of Iran and Tehran chambers of commerce Tuesday.

The IR Leader touched on the large drives accomplished by the nation in the past few years and urged the authorities to avoid any pessimistic assessment of the conditions on the ground.
